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PARKING PERMITS

Students who drive a vehicle to GHHS are required to have a 19-20 GHHS parking permit. Permits can be purchased in the bookkeeper's office for \$40 with a valid driver's license (not a permit).

Only 500 permits will be sold due to limited parking spaces. As of this newsletter, we have sold 300. Once permits sell out, no additional permits will be issued and no other student vehicles will be permitted to park on campus. If you are a student and currently drive a vehicle to school, you are urged to purchase your parking permit right away. Parking tickets for vehicles without 19-20 permits will start being issued October 14th. Any vehicle found on campus without a permit could be cited and/or impounded. Likewise, students are only to park in student designated areas. Students who park in staff or visitor areas, block roadways, or park in fire lanes, could also have their vehicles cited and/or impounded.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Your child's daily, on time attendance is critical to their success in school. While some challenges to your child's attendance are unavoidable, it's important to understand the impact of each absence. When your child is not in class, they are missing out on critical learning. This puts them at risk of falling behind and not graduating from high school. Even as little as two absences in a month, whether excused or unexcused, can make a big difference in their academic performance. In fact, a student who misses two days per month will end up missing 10% of the school year. You can help your student achieve by encouraging them to be present, everyday.

A couple of quick reminders from the attendance office:

- Be sure to call our attendance line to excuse absences within 48 hours of the absence. Also, remember it is necessary to include the date and reason for missing school for students to be considered excused.
- If you are planning an extended absence or vacation, be sure to contact the attendance office for a planned absence form. These need to be signed by teachers and administrators to ensure that staff are aware of the upcoming absences and students are provided the opportunity to collect the work they will miss while out of school.
- Students who arrive late or leave early from school need to check out through the attendance office. Failure to check out is considered a closed campus violation and may result in the absences being considered unexcused.



WINTER SPORTS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTER EARLY AS PRACTICES/TRYOUTS FOR MOST SPORTS BEGIN MONDAY, NOVEMBER 18TH.

BOWLING BEGINS ON NOVEMBER 4TH.

Registration for 2019-2020 Winter Athletics (basketball, wrestling, bowling, boys swim and dive) will begin **October 8th**.

Deadline for bowling registration is October 26th.

The deadline for all other sports is **November 9th**, to allow for processing.

Please see the instructions below to register:

- Ensure you have a recent physical exam document on file with the athletic office. Please note: your physical is good for 24 months but CANNOT expire during the sport season for which you are registering.
 - 2. Visit the <u>GHHS Athletics Home Page</u>.
- 3. Click the "Register for Athletics on FamilyID" link to begin your registration.

4. Please be sure to complete all screens until you have confirmation that you have completed registration. You may pay online by going back to the GHHS website and choosing "Pay for Athletics" or by bringing a check to the bookkeeper. For basketball, please wait until rosters are complete to make your payment.

 If your son/daughter has any health concerns, please be sure to have the current paperwork completed and received by our school nurse to review and ensure a health plan is current.

FAFSA/WASFA

ALL students are encouraged to apply for financial aid.

Students eligible for <u>federal</u> student aid should submit the <u>FAFSA</u>. Those not eligible for federal aid (undocumented students, etc.), may be eligible for <u>state</u> aid by submitting the <u>WASFA</u>. For those unsure, please complete this <u>questionnaire</u> to determine which application to use. This will lead to the correct application. (Some browsers may not work for this questionnaire. Firefox seems to work better than Chrome.)

Both applications open **October 1**st, and are based on **2018** taxes. Whether you think your family qualifies or not, many higher ed institutions use this for granting scholarships, grants, and other types of financial aid.
